# Volunteers needed for a study of **POST-STROKE APHASIA**

The Department of Rehabilitation Medicine, New York University School of Medicine needs persons with **post-stroke aphasia** to take part in an international collaborative research study designed to determine the factors which help one live successfully with aphasia.

- Participation includes 3 visits over a 9 month period.
- Each session lasts approximately 2 hours. Scheduling is flexible.
- Potential participants must be 18 years of age and older, fluent in English before stroke, and have aphasia due to stroke, with an onset of  $\leq 2.5$  months or 3.5 months post-stroke.
- A significant other, family member, or friend must also agree to take part in the study to assist in the completion of questionnaires.
- Participants will be compensated \$30 following the initial visit, \$30 following the second visit, and \$50 following the final visit.
